Hours of Operation

- Minimum temperature for opening is 69 Degrees; if the pool does not open, check at 4pm

- Closing Day is the Monday of Labor Day Weekend
- MAY - JULY: M-F 12pm - 8pm / Saturday & Sunday 11am - 8pm
- 4th OF JULY: 11 am - 6 pm
- AUGUST (Start of School) - LABOR DAY: M-F 12pm - 7pm / Saturday & Sunday 11pm - 8pm

Nassau Swim Club Pool Rules

Safety is our NUMBER ONE priority. The pool rules are designed to make each visit to Nassau safe and enjoyable, while promoting the privacy, safety, and dignity of all members, guests, and especially, our children. The Nassau Board, Manager, and Lifeguards are tasked with enforcing these rules. Please take a moment to review them with your family:

1. Any child using the diving board must be able to swim the width of the diving well, **UNLESS** a parent is in the pool working with their child and has approval from the Manager/Guard on duty. Floatation devices can be used with parent supervision. The Manager/Guard may check the child's ability at any time.
2. Free swimming is not permitted in the diving well **UNLESS** the Guard gives permission.
3. Hourly breaks require all patrons under 18 to vacate the pools for adults only time.
4. The Baby Pool is reserved for children under 6. If a child is not potty-trained, swim diapers **MUST** be worn in the pools.
5. Absolutely **NO FOOD or GLASS** is permitted on any of the pool deck areas, including around the baby pool, as required by the Delaware County Board of Health.
6. Nassau is a Smoke Free facility. **NO SMOKING OR VAPING** is permitted on any of the grounds, including the parking lot.
7. **NO ALCOHOL, DRUGS or WEAPONS** are permitted. Use of these on Nassau property could result in prosecution and revocation of membership.
8. No reusable water balloons or squirt guns are permitted in the pool.
9. No rafts or large floats are permitted in the pool.
10. Only soft Nerf or sponge-type balls may be used in the pool.
11. **NO RUNNING** on the pool decks, please remind your children!
12. All members and guests using the pools must wear family-friendly swimwear. No thongs.
13. After using the sand area, please rinse off in the shower before using the pool.
14. Children must be 12 or older to visit the pool without a parent. This privilege may be revoked if pool rules are not followed. Parents will be contacted if situations arise that require intervention.
15. Cell phones, tablets, cameras, and any devices capable of capturing photos or videos are strictly prohibited in the bathhouse (restrooms/showers/changing areas). Violation of this rule may result in suspension or loss of membership.
